<p>Other candidate details, to include: tenure in office, committees they’ve sat on or chaired, voting record on issues related to policing and/or criminal justice reform (i.e., gun control, etc.), other political offices they’ve held</p>	<p>Committees</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Appropriations Committee ● Innovation, Technology and Economic Development Committee, Chair ● State Government and Tribal Relations Committee <p>Voting record</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Sponsored WA HB2231 - Concerning bail jumping; Requires a person to be given written notice of the requirement of a subsequent personal appearance for trial before any court of this state, and fails to appear for trial as required before being considered to have jumped bail. ● Sponsored HB 1280 - Concerning property crime sentencing; change sentencing for property crime from prison sentences to supervision & treatment. ● Sponsored H-3533.1 - Concerning use of technology by Law Enforcement; LE may not procure or use facial recognition technology without explicit approval of its respective legislative authority, given for that specific technology to be used for a specific purpose. ● Sponsored HB 1225 - Concerning domestic violence & Law Enforcement: Enhances the safety of domestic violence victims, families, and officers by establishing policies and requirements regarding law enforcement response to domestic violence incidents. ● Sponsored HB 1488 - Concerning eliminating the death penalty; Eliminates the death penalty and requires life imprisonment without possibility of release or parole as the sentence for aggravated first degree murder. ● Sponsored HB 1541 - Concerning weapon/possession orders; Prohibiting the possession and acquisition of weapons by persons convicted of certain criminal offenses or subject to certain no-contact orders, protection orders, or restraining orders.
