<p>Candidate priority issues</p>	<p>Pledges to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Push for policies that work for all people, not just the 1%</li> <li>● Income inequality and corporate accountability - establishing a “People’s Bank” owned by the state of Washington, supporting public broadband, supporting progressive tax reform, corporate compliance with international standards</li> <li>● Affordable housing - increase mixed income multi-generational public housing, using the People’s Bank to provide bridge loans; increase resources for women/children in domestic violence; increase mandatory inclusionary zoning requirements; stop selling public land</li> <li>● Homelessness - support tiny houses, job training, wraparound mental/behavioral health, drug and alcohol treatments, LEAD program/intervention training for police; strengthen eviction protections</li> <li>● Healthcare - create Washington Health Security Trust to provide healthcare for all, expand public health systems, provide reproductive rights and care for all, provide funding for substance abuse disorder treatment and behavioral health services</li> <li>● Transit - high speed light rail financed by People’s Bank, ensure greater transparency, accountability and equity with Sound Transit administration, understand impact of bike plans and pedestrian walkways</li> <li>● Small business development - provide technical training and assistance, support tax relief, commercial rent stabilization, displacement protection, support measures for minority and women-owned businesses</li> <li>● Equity - through education, criminal justice system, community outreach, youth programs, paid family leave, pay equity, et al</li> </ul>
