<p>Other candidate details, to include: tenure in office, committees they've sat on or chaired, voting record on issues related to policing and/or criminal justice reform (i.e., gun control, etc.), other political offices they've held</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Appointed by Inslee January 2019</li> <li>● Vice Chair of College &amp; Workforce Development Committee</li> <li>● Transportation Committee</li> <li>● Innovation, Technology &amp; Economic Development Committee</li> <li>● Primary sponsor for HB 2856, a moratorium on facial recognition, which is currently in the House in committee</li> <li>● Secondary sponsor for HB 1732, identifying and responding to bias-based offenses. Passed both House and Senate and the governor's desk. Now in Session Law</li> <li>● In February 2019, Entenman passed her first bill to crack down on sex traffickers. HB 1055 amended current law to allow for the warrantless arrest for violation of a no-contact order for Promoting Prostitution and Trafficking when probable cause exists. This allows police officers to arrest a trafficker who has a no-contact order against them and has been determined to be a threat. Previously there was a delay in arresting probable sex traffickers because of violations of the no contact orders</li> <li>● Previous position was District Director for South King County and leading outreach efforts for Adam Smith</li> <li>● Currently serves on the board for Renton Technical College Board of Trustees</li> <li>● Former board member for Neighborhood House and Kent Youth and Family Services</li> <li>● Current member of the Urban League of Metropolitan Seattle</li> </ul>
