

## Action for HB 1054

HB 1054 on police tactics/de-escalation has been moved out of the Public Safety Committee to the Rules Committee, which means **it's eligible to go to the floor**. Click on their name to get to the page where you can send them your comments. NOTE: Remember to click on the "verify district" button. *Pro Tip: You can copy and paste the same message to each member.*

It is time to now advocate directly to the Rules members. If one of them is your legislator, remind them you are a constituent. When you email the Rules members, ask them to "pull" the bill. **Keep it super short.** "Please pull HB 1054, it will (insert your reason)."

Some suggested reasons:

1. Be one step forward to true comprehensive police reform/accountability.
2. Clearly define what law enforcement can and cannot use to arrest a civilian, thereby decreasing the potential for unwarranted harm or death.
3. De-escalate a situation at the outset of an encounter with armed law enforcement, which could prevent a deadly outcome.
4. Help make Washington State a leader in the country on true comprehensive police reform/accountability.
